## The History of Two Ridges Presbyterian Church

The Two Ridges Presbyterian Church was formed on October 19, 1802. Worship services were held in area homes until the first church was constructed in 1810 in the cemetery. It was made of logs and used primarily in the winter months. A second church was built in 1818.

In 1853, a new church was constructed on the hilltop where the current church is located. That building existed when Confederate Raider of General John Hunt Morgan passed through the area in July 1863. A skirmish took place near the church. A 1913 monument sits in the front yard of the church commemorating the event.

In 1887, the current church building was erected using parts of the older building in its structure. The white church with its red doors has served as a beacon of light to all who pass.

An addition was constructed in 1970 to provide offices, classrooms and a Fellowship Hall for the church and public.

The famous steeple was lowered in 2001 and completely replicated and returned to its position atop the building. The 1887 bell was returned to its belfry and again rings to gather the Faithful.
